What to Bring

Miramar Farms is set on 11 acres for your group to explore and enjoy. This is a working farm--and the ground is uneven in some areas. We encourage comfortable clothing and good walking shoes to help you take advantage of all the private outdoor meeting areas, walking trails and ocean views.

What Not to Bring

Pets are not allowed on the farm. Smoking is also prohibited.

Help Us Meet Our Sustainability Goals

Miramar Farms grows a wide range of row crops and flowers organically. We are currently implementing a Conservation and Carbon Farm Plan—which focuses on sustainable soil, water and waste management practices, as well as opportunities for carbon capture. You can help us meet our sustainability goals in three ways:

1. If at all possible, carpool (or vanpool) with others when coming to the farm.
2. Bring your favorite reusable water bottle and/or coffee mug with you for the day.
3. Do not bring single-use plastic or other environmentally unfriendly materials (that cannot be composted or recycled) to the farm.

Other Tips for Having a Great Day

We encourage you to unplug while you're here as much as you can. However, we have wireless access and high speed internet across much of the property and in the barn meeting space. Cell coverage is excellent on Verizon and T-Mobile (and much less consistent on AT&T).

The speed limit coming to the farm (once you leave Highway 1) is 7 miles per hour. Please drive carefully and protect our neighborhood chickens, puppy dogs, foxes and kids!

Driving Directions:

Follow Instructions below or use **GOOGLE Maps** and ask for “Miramar Farms” (**NOTE: To avoid getting lost, do not use street # address—use the place name!**)

From San Jose and Other Points South:

- Take 280 North or 101 North to 92 West towards Half Moon Bay.
- Make a right onto Highway 1 North.
- Drive approximately 3 miles; turn right on Alto.
- Take immediate left at the T-intersection and continue straight and slightly to the right onto Purisima Way.
- Take a deep breath and **drive slowly** down the one-lane country road. Speed Limit is 7MPH.
- Note: Do not take any of the right hand turns up the hill. Continue straight (and flat) on Purisima Way to where it dead-ends (PLEASE DO NOT ENTER FIGONE RANCH); you will see a row of mailboxes to your right.
- Make a right into the driveway.
- Parking lot is on the right, past the little greenhouse. Welcome to Miramar Farms!

From San Francisco and Other Points North:

- Take 280 South to Highway 1 South in Daly City.
- Continue on 1 South through Pacifica and the Devil’s Slide tunnel.
- Continue south on Highway 1 past Princeton Harbor and watch for the large road sign for Miramar Dr. on your left.
- Turn left on Miramar Dr. (note: when you see a sign for Medio Rd., you are getting close; Miramar is next).
- At the three-point intersection, turn left onto Purisima Way.
- Take a deep breath and **drive slowly** down the one-lane country road. **Speed Limit is 7MPH.**
- Note: Do not take any of the right hand turns up the hill. Continue straight (and flat) on Purisima Way to where it dead-ends (PLEASE DO NOT ENTER FIGONE RANCH); you will see a row of mailboxes to your right.
- Make a right into the driveway.
- Parking lot is on the right, past the little greenhouse. Welcome to Miramar Farms!
